

¹⁹ Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. ²⁰ For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

²¹ But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— ²² the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵ whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. ²⁶ It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

²⁷ Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. ²⁸ For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

"THE RIGHTEOUS BOAST" (1 CORINTHIANS 1)

²⁷ But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; ²⁸ God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, ²⁹ so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. ³⁰ And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, ³¹ so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

FINANCIAL REVIEW COMMITTEE... A Worklist presented to (and adopted by) Faith's Board of Directors:

1. Do a financial review of the student tuition and fee collection, recording, depositing and reporting system.

Outcome - A report with recommended improvements (if any) made to the church board for adoption.

2. Do a financial review of two or more special and/or dedicated funds.

Outcome - A brief report with findings. Recommended improvements will be included in item #3

3. Dedicated fund work process review and recommendations

Outcome – A Dedicated Fund Guideline document to be recommended to the church board for adoption.

4. Recommend a GASSO Scholarship Awarding work process. Work with the school board.

Outcome – A GASSO Scholarship Awarding Guideline document to be recommended to the church board for adoption.

5. Review the "Capital Campaign". Purpose, timeline, accounting of funds in/out. Recommended improvements for future use in a possible new campaign.

Outcome – A Capital Campaign report to be presented to the church board for their approval and for sharing with the congregation.

6. Review the church board and school board balanced budgeting process. Address timing, facilities upkeep and debt reduction. Recommend a yearly budget framework with key milestones and a multi-year planning projection process.

Outcome – A brief report on the review findings and a Budgeting Framework document to be presented to the church board for their approval and adoption.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) from Traditional IRAs

Here is an excerpt from an LCMS Mission Advancement communication: Are you aware that you can make a significant charitable impact by redirecting some of your traditional IRA funds? Under current federal law, individuals 73 years of age and above who own a traditional individual retirement account (IRA) must take an annual required minimum distribution (RMD)... However, those who are 70½ years of age can also choose to give from their IRA before they must take the annual RMD.

Please note: **Qualified Charitable Distributions** can satisfy *required minimum distribution* and do not generate a taxable event for the donor nor the nonprofit. Many LCMS parishioners (including some at Faith) are already tithing through QCDs. This giving opportunity is to be promoted for others over age 70.5 to consider with their charitable intent.
