

NICENE CREED *(Stand)*

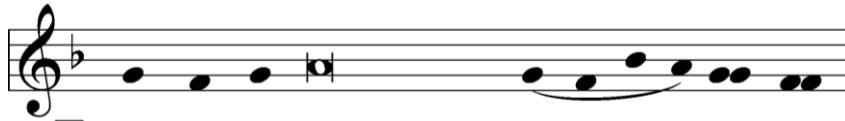

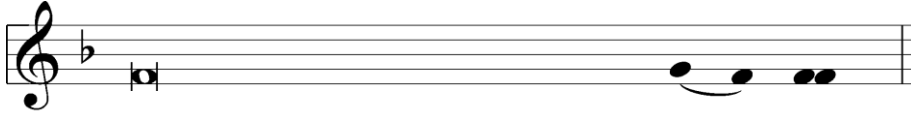
