**Week 17 – JESUS HEALS THE SICK (Matthew 8:1-17, pp. 131-137)**

In the readings for this week, we see multiple instances of Jesus healing the sick and dying. In His work as a healer, Jesus values the human body and affirms its importance and place in the life of the world to come.

**Why are our bodies so susceptible to illness and decay?** \_\_\_\_\_
