As God's baptized and forgiven people, we gather at His invitation to receive The Lord's Supper.

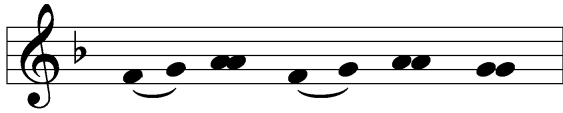
